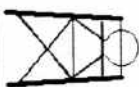

"The Courier of Mines"

1. The letter bag will be made up & dispatched from the Epsom library at 8am, & from the Sir Charles Hotham Hotel at 9am, returning with the letters immediately on the arrival & sorting of the mail, arriving at Epsom at half-past 12.

2. A fee of sixpence each **Letter & Paper**, to or from, the post for carriage, exclusive of postage.

3. Subscriptions of **2 shillings per week** includes the carriage of all letters & newspapers to or from the post.

4. Persons wishing to have their letters brought will please to register their names (Christian & surname) in full, either at the Sir Charles Hotham Hotel, or the Epsom library, & will be retained on the register one month only, when it must be renewed
No charge for registering.
